## AUCTION PROCESS

### 1. Always use your primary phone number for faster bidding.

It's easy to register when you call to place a bid. Using your primary phone number helps you bid quickly during the auction. If you participated during the last five years, you're already in our system and ready to bid!

### 2. Choose your favorite works of art.

Explore the collection at [kvie.org/artauction](http://kvie.org/artauction). Note the date and time your favorite pieces are scheduled to air, and call in to bid!

### 3. How to Bid?

Bidding is conducted by telephone. Tune in before your art comes up-for-bid and be ready to call. When the auctioneer announces your item, call toll-free **(844) KVIE-ART**. Most items are sold within 5-8 minutes.

### 4. Confirmation and Payment

If you are the winning bidder, KVIE staff will confirm your bid and process payment immediately after the item closes. KVIE accepts credit cards, and we are required by law to collect CA sales tax.

### 5. Art Pickup

Confirmed winners may pick up purchases at KVIE Studios October 7-11 (see *website for hours*). Shipping can be arranged for an additional charge. You will receive a sales receipt upon item pickup.

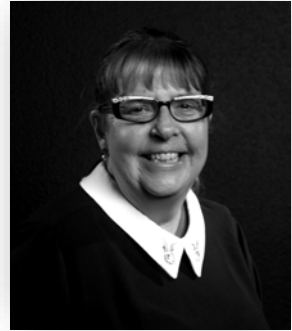

## FROM THE CURATOR

Each year I look forward to my busy time - putting together the auction and curating the collection. I find this process exciting and (at times) a bit overwhelming!

We start the process in April when we receive over 400 entries in our on-line call for artists and another 100 at the in-person entry day. I go through each entry, looking at artistic merit, how it fits with the collection and how it will show well on live TV. I select 260 of these pieces and I also make many studio visits to personally select the California Masters works.

In July, the jury selects the winners in each category and we photograph and catalog the works. August brings the daunting task of putting all these pieces into time slots and galleries for the final auction - the **Rotation**.

This year we are pleased to present some exciting new categories. This year we received many equestrian pieces so we have a horse themed break to follow birdwatching and Farm to Fork. Also included is the Huell Howser inspired California's Gold as well as Yosemite and A Day at the Beach hour. This means it will be easy for you to find the perfect piece for a beach house, something to brighten a kitchen or a stunning photo to commemorate the family's yearly trip to Yosemite!

I encourage you to view the collection on line, mark the times that your favorite themes will be on and, as always...

# 2017 JURORS

**Contemporary Classics - Micah Crandall-Bear** exhibits internationally as well as in private galleries in Palm Springs, Sacramento and San Francisco. His work is in many corporate collections including Facebook, The University of California, Davis and Paragary's.

**Figurative - Boyd Gavin** has a Master's Degree in art (California State University, Sacramento) and has exhibited widely since his debut at the Crocker Art Museum at the age of 16. He has exhibited in the John Natsoulas Gallery, Caldwell Snyder in San Francisco, and has work in the permanent collection of The Crocker Art Museum.



**Landscapes (includes California's Gold) - David Sobon** is a well-known auctioneer, a popular mainstay of many successful fundraising events and auctions for local non-profits in our area. He is also a long-time collector and connoisseur of the California Landscape.



**Still Life - Miles Hermann** exhibited most recently at the Tim Collom Gallery in Sacramento, and previously in the Pence Art Gallery. His work is collected on a national level and he was mentored by Gregory Kondos before attending the College of Arts and Crafts.



**Photography - Patrick O'Kane** has owned and operated Cali Color in Sacramento for over 25 years - one of the first fine art print shops to feature scanning and printing for local artists and photographers. Patrick has a keen eye for photography as well as a background in the technical aspects of fine art photography.



**Sculpture - Dr. Lee Kavaljian** is a professor at Sacramento State and has a Ph.D. from the University of Chicago. In his 90s Lee continues to exhibit his ceramic works in private galleries and public museums. His work is widely collected and he is well respected by generations of local ceramicists.

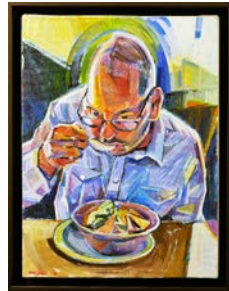

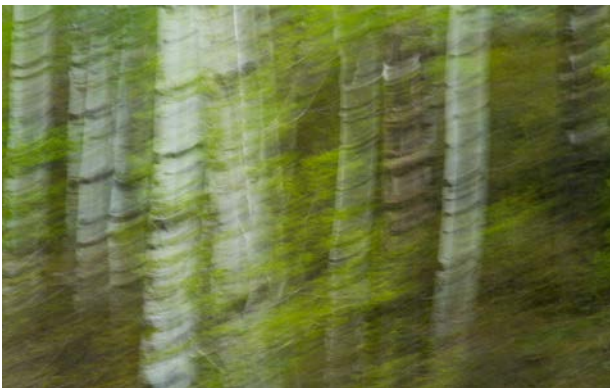

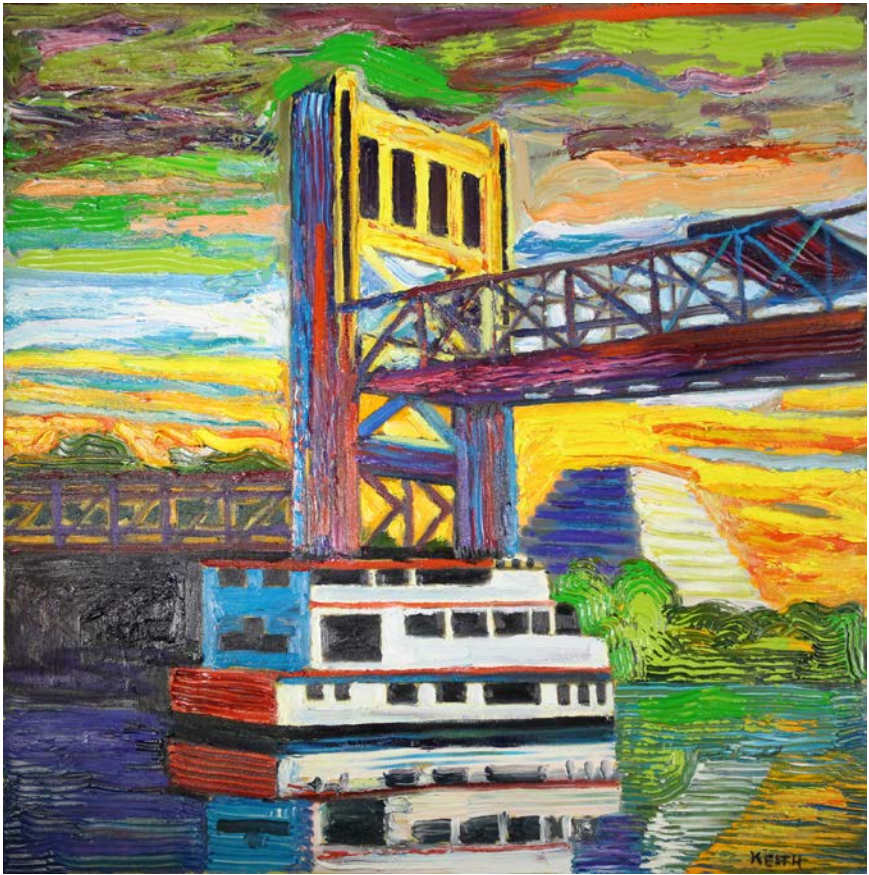
